

DECK GUIDELINES

As part of the Bio Studio Expression of Interest process, we ask you to submit a slide deck with an overview of the proposed project in a **non-confidential** format.

Please aim to cover the key information related to the considerations below and adhere to the allocated slide numbers.

You may provide a maximum of 5 slides.

The problem

Description of the specific problem that you want to solve. Consider covering:

- *What is the nature of the problem and why does it exist?*
- *What is the size of the market?*
- *What are the limitations of current solutions?*
- *What are the health or societal impacts of this problem?*

(up to 2 slides)

The solution

Description of the proposed solution developed through the Bio Studio project. Consider covering:

- *What is the commercial product?*
- *How does the proposed solution address the described problem?*
- *Why is the timing right for this project?*
- *What are the advantages of the proposed solution compared to competition?*
- *Key data supporting your proposed approach/solution.*
- *Who is your customer and how do you envision entering the market?*

(up to 2 slides)

Project Plan

To be able to move from research to a company stage, it is important we focus on the right milestones to ensure validation as well as de-risking of the project.

What are key development activities (science, IP, business development) and milestones for the proposed 3-year Bio Studio project. Please provide a Gantt chart with:

- An overview of key activities (including experimental plan) and milestones (indication which activities could take place at the BII)*
